

AWGA Eclectic (EC) Guidelines

Beginning 2015

The EC will be manually kept by each lady. There will be a container in the proshop with cards for everyone. If there is not a card for you, please let Chris, Carla, Sherry or Sheryl know and we will make you one. After your first round you will circle the best score for that day. After that, you will only make changes on your card where you improve on a hole.

After each Thursday's postable score and both days of the Club Championship, each lady is responsible for updating their own EC card. Please update cards weekly. Cards will be filed in order, last name then first name. We will use gross scores only. However when payouts are determined, we will use 75% on your handicap as on October 15, 2015. Therefore there will be gross and net payouts. Everyone is eligible regardless of the number of rounds you play.

The plan is to make 4 flights. With the B flight being the biggest, the committee will equally divide the flights. So rather than letters for flights, we will have flights, 1, 2, 3, and 4. The committee has decided that paying more people was more important than the amount each person gets. Ideally the goal is to pay at least half of the ladies participating in the EC tracking.

The last day to update your card is Thursday October 15, 2015. This will give the committee time to review all cards, and calculate the handicaps and determine the payouts. Through 2019, the last day to update your card will be the 2nd Thursday in October.
