Tournament Information:

Double Alternate Shot- February 9, 2019

The 4th Annual Double Alternate Shot game will be held Saturday, February 9th. This is a 2-Man Alternate Shot event with a twist...two balls in play! Here is how it works:

- Player A tees off with Ball 1
- Player B tees off with Ball 2
- Player A hits the second shot for Ball 2
- Player B hits the second shot for Ball 1
- This alternate rotation is continued until each ball is holed*

*Only the better ball (gross) counts toward team score. Both balls do not need to be holed. Team net scores calculated by taking team handicap (1/2 combined) off of 18-hole score.

Entry Fee is \$20.00 per team. **Maximum of 10-stroke differential between partners.** Make your own teams and starting times.

Bingo-Bango-Bongo- February 23, 2019

The 24th Annual Bingo-Bango-Bongo Tournament will be held Saturday, February 23rd. This 2-Man game plays six holes of three formats: Best Ball, Chapman, and Scramble. Players will play from the Blue Tees or White Tees (if age + handicap = 87 or more). Entry fee is \$30.00 per team.

Form your own teams and starting times.

In order to have proper scorecards and handicaps calculated for this event, please make sure to make your tee time with partner names together on the tee sheet.

Arrowhead Men's Club Match Play Championship

Begins: Monday, March 11th
Ends: Sunday, April 21st



Who: All Arrowhead Men's Club members (18 years of age and older)

Format: Singles Match Play (Net)
Handicap Flights of eight (8) players

Tees: Blue Tees -or- White Tees (age + handicap = 87 or more)

When: Matches begin Monday, March 11th
Matches end Sunday, April 21st
Players will have two (2) weeks to play their match*. (Weeks run Mon-Sun)

Handicapping: March 1, 2019 handicaps will be used to determine flights and used throughout the entirety of the Match Play event. Net matches- stroke differential will be given to the higher handicapped player on hardest rated hole(s).

Entry: \$20.00. Cash or Check only.
Entry Deadline: Wednesday, March 6th @ 5:00 pm

*In the event that players cannot agree to play their match during the allotted time period, the player that is on Arrowhead property at 9:00 am on the last day of the allotted time period will be declared the winner by default.

OGA Rules Workshop:

Saturday, February 16th

With the “New Rules” in golf for 2019, the Oregon Golf Association will be holding a Rules Workshop at Arrowhead Golf Club on Saturday, February 16th. The workshop will run from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. The cost is \$35.00 per person, and includes the workshop, light breakfast, and lunch. To register, please visit the [OGA’s website](#).

Additionally, The USGA has several resources available for you to utilize when studying the rules changes. They have several videos posted on their website for explain and demonstrate the new rules. ([Click here to view videos](#)). Rule books are also available on your [iOS](#) or [Android](#) mobile devices. These are fantastic resources available to you, as it is easy to use keywords to search for rulings. A summary sheet of the rules changes can be found [here](#).

Please note: The rules changes allow for clubs to adopt a local rule regarding the out-of-bounds dropping procedure. This procedure is not in effect at Arrowhead Golf Club. The procedure for a ball hit out-of-bounds remains stroke and distance.

We are in the process of converting all the “yellow-stake hazards” to “red-stake penalty areas”. This will allow for a two-club-length drop from all penalty areas. This should be completed before March 1st.

OGA/USGA Handicap Score Posting Season- Begins March 1st

The official OGA Handicapping season begins March 1, 2019. All members that had an OGA/USGA Handicap Card at Arrowhead in 2018 have been billed for the 2019 season. This fee was on the statement you receive at the beginning of January. For new and current members that do not have an OGA/USGA Handicap, and wish to have one, please sign up in the Golf Shop at this time. **Having a handicap established through Arrowhead is required to play in Men’s or Women’s Club events.**

The annual handicap fees for 2019 are as follows:

Men- \$87, includes Men’s Club dues, handicap fee, and Hole-in-One insurance (\$10).

Women- \$65, includes AWGA dues, handicap fee, and Hole-in-One insurance (\$5).

Upon payment of your fee, you will receive a semi-monthly OGA/USGA Handicap Card which is recognized throughout the US and British Isles. In addition, you are eligible to enter Arrowhead Men’s or Women’s Club events and many OGA, PNGA, and USGA events, depending on your handicap.

Your OGA/USGA Handicap Card indicates you are a member of a recognized Golf Club and promotes fair and balanced competition. Sign up today for your OGA/USGA Handicap Card and begin posting your 2019 scores on March 1st.

The GHIN system will be transitioning to a new platform in the coming months. Due to this change, each golfer in the GHIN system will need to have a unique email address. If you share an email address with your spouse, please notify the golf shop or update your GHIN account with a unique email.

Around the Greens with Adam Vidourek

We've had a nice stretch of weather this last week or so, but looking to be colder in February with chances of snow coming our way. Hopefully many of you have taken advantage of the nice weather so far and got a some good rounds under your belt.

As mentioned at the annual meeting, we have some very exciting news...We are in discussion with a contractor about completing the bunker project that's been a topic of discussion since I arrived here at Arrowhead. This project is planned to begin the last week of August and take approximately six weeks to complete. We will know more after next week, following our planning meeting with the contractor.

We just recently thinned out one of the trees behind 13 green to allow more sunlight through to help improve turf quality. We will do the other as time allows and are working on a plan to provide more sunlight to the other shaded greens. Holes 6 and 7 are the most important ones, as they are in the most shade and take a beating during the winter months.

During the cold weather, often times the surface layer of the greens are slightly frozen at the beginning of the round but thaw out toward the end. When they are slightly frozen, it is very difficult to repair ball marks. If it is a little later in the day, and the greens are thawed out, please help out by repairing the ball marks that you see. It will certainly improve the putting green conditions for everyone.

Also, please make sure to properly dispose of garbage on the course. Candy wrappers, chip bags, drink bottles, sunflower seeds, and ORANGE PEELS! We have been consistently finding orange peels on tee boxes, fairways, collars... you name it. Please make sure to use the garbage cans located on the tee boxes.

Hope you've all enjoyed the year so far! I am looking forward to another fun-filled year at Arrowhead Golf Club!


New Offering...Massage Therapy:
